

**ENVIRONMENT** (based on Pope Francis' encyclical Laudato Sí, On Care for Our Common Home): Sustainability, climate actions, earth day programs, environmental justice, ecology

**IMMIGRATION** (based on John 17:21 – “That all may be one as you Father, and I are one.”): Border conditions, accompanying immigrants at court, integrating immigrants into society

**BASIC HUMAN NEEDS** (based on Corporal Works of Mercy 1-4): Providing food, clothing, and shelter for those needing care

· **JUSTICE INEQUITY** (based on Matthew 5:6 – Hungering and thirsting for righteousness): racism, voter suppression, gerrymandering, criminal justice reform, unjust laws

**PROTECTION OF ALL HUMAN LIFE** (based on Matthew 25:40 – “Whatever you do to the least of my brothers and sisters, you do to me.”): Abortion, all of life womb to tomb, capital punishment

· **TRAINING, EDUCATION, AND OUTREACH** (based on the Spiritual Works of Mercy – instruct the ignorant and counsel the doubtful and John 17:21 – “...that all may be one.”): Study of Pope Francis encyclicals and other writings, social teaching of the church, pastor's weekly bulletin column, listening sessions
