Build Back Better. Do We Choose Poverty by Our Votes and Actions?

"Poverty is a policy choice. Our elected officials have the tools and financial resources to address the economic injustices communities across America are facing. The problem is they sometimes lack the political courage and moral conviction to act....

Decades of intentional underinvestment in families and communities have perpetuated socioeconomic, racial, ethnic, and cultural disparities. For example, in 2017, Congress enacted historic tax cuts for the rich and major corporations that inflated our deficit by over one trillion dollars. Since then, Americans have struggled to make ends meet, a situation worsened by a deadly pandemic.

There has been a lot of discussion around the Build Back Better Act. This historic and restorative piece of legislation honors the inherent dignity and worth of our families in rural, urban, and suburban communities who have been devastated by COVID-19's impact on top of decades of being under-resourced and under-served.

You may have heard talk of the cost of the package—\$1.75 trillion dollars. But the high number is not the issue at hand. In 2017, Congress passed tax cuts for the wealthiest 1 percent and profitable corporations that will add another \$3.9 trillion to our national debt. Just last month, Congress passed a defense spending bill totaling \$768 billion dollars. Combined, that is nearly \$5 trillion dollars of debt. Why is it that our country can increase the wealth of those who have more than enough and purchase instruments of war, but can't tend to those who need resources and support to thrive?

The Build Back Better Act would drastically improve the quality of life for millions of families. From health care to housing, childcare to our environment, Congress can make the decision to help all Americans regardless of who they voted for, what they look like, or where they live. This bill would provide families and individuals with the resources necessary to actualize their full potential as beloved children made in the image of God—Imago Dei.
