If you are looking for some positive actions to promote / celebrate St. Francis in this Season of Creation, here are a few to consider.

SHARE YOUR HOME

Take good care of your pets.

Adopt a shelter dog or cat.

Foster a shelter or rescued dog or cat.

Volunteer at an animal shelter or SPCA.

Donate to or volunteer at a cat rescue and neuter program.

SHARE YOUR YARD

Plant native trees, bushes, or perennial flowers that support and protect insects, birds, and wildlife.

Reduce lawn size.

Avoid using pesticides or poisons that sicken and kill animals in the natural environment. Provide water for birds and wildlife.

When possible 'leave the leaves.'

Learn about wildlife so you understand and are not intimidated by their behavior.

Be good neighbors to non-human creatures.

SHARE YOUR COMMUNITY

Pick up trash along the way.

Support organizations that care for injured and orphaned animals or migrating animals such as birds, toads, turtles, and horseshoe crabs.

Drive carefully, especially at dusk and dawn, when wildlife might be crossing the roads. Support local environmental organizations such as the Schuylkill Environmental Education Center, Fairmount Park, Wissahickon Park, Lights Out Philly, Philadelphia Metro Wildlife Center, and Wetlands Institute.
